The partners discussed the document IO1 -HANDBOOK. The structure of this document was agreed:

- 1. Laws and legislation connected with the right

IO3 NON-FORMAL EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES IN CLASS

The first part of the output has been produced by PRSC, it has to be integrated with lesson plans and example of activities on how to include the fairytales of rights in the luggage in education. PRSC has shared a template. Each partner has to present 1 example of the already implemented activities **until 17**th **June**. After a general discussion the main themes proposed are:













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- PRSC: cooperation among teachers to include the activity in the formal curricula
- SINAPTICA: extra-school activities in the libraries
- ITALY: activities of theater of puppets and lessons on storytelling on rights
- ARID: involve seniors in school lesson
- MIB: involvement of the VET school and external experts in carpentry
- SPAIN: Collaboration between adult and senior's centres, infant and primary schools and an organizing team of an international puppet festival

IO 7- A BRIDGE BETWEEN GENERATION

The Spanish partners are responsible for the final document. Marian joined the meeting remotely and introduced the structure of the document:
